Dear Family Member;

This memo is to update you on the status of the Huscroft Educational Trust. In January of this year, there were no new applications for Spring 2011 and no new applications for Fall 2011. There were two applications for renewal for Spring 2011 and no applications for renewal for Fall 2011.

Spring 2011 awards were promised to previous recipients to support their ongoing studies as follows:

Amanda Edis	\$6,000	Brigham Young University Idaho, Education

These awards will generally be paid in two installments, however, the award to Colten will be paid as one installment only. The Advisory Board of the Huscroft Educational Trust recommended these awards based on the criteria set out in the trust document:

1. Economic potential of the trade or profession chosen and degree, diploma or certificate sought
2. Financial need of the applicant
3. Academic achievement or trade skill of the applicant
4. Cost and location of the educational institution relative to other equivalent educational options
5. Age of applicant; with priority being given to youth
6. Equity amongst beneficiary groups within the Huscroft Family

In addition to these new awards, previously committed awards will be paid in February 2011 to Marin Cocks, Aaron Edis, Brittany Corwin, Jordan Huscroft, Matthew Brown, Shelby Corwin, and Richard Brown. Total payments by the Huscroft Educational Trust in February 2011 will be \$26,750. Payments are made upon timely receipt of a payment request containing proof of admittance or transcripts as outlined in the award letters. By the end of February 2011, the Huscroft Educational Trust will have paid a total of \$504,475 to students as follows:

The next awards will be for Fall 2011 and Spring 2012. It is anticipated that \$70,000 (Canadian) per year will be awarded through distributions of small (\$1,000) to large (\$8,000) annual awards. Awards may be given for multiple years, but must be renewed each year. Applications for Fall 2011 must be received by July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2011 to be considered. Note that applications can be made just 3 months prior to the first payment date, instead of 9 months prior to the first payment date, as was done in years past. Thus applications for Spring 2012 can be submitted by July 15, 2011 or January 15, 2012. Early applications will typically receive preference. Applications should be sent to the chairperson of the Advisory Board, Patricia Huscroft, at the address, fax or email given below. Use of email is preferred in order to ensure that documents arrive before the deadline and allow the sender to review the clarity and completeness of what is being sent. Emailed documents must be sent as one PDF file. Original documents that are sent by regular mail should also be scanned and sent by email. We intend to move soon to accepting email documents only. If applicants do not receive an acknowledgement of receipt of their application within a week, they should investigate and contact Patricia Huscroft. The application forms are available on line at [www.huscroft.ca](http://www.huscroft.ca) where the application procedures are explained in detail.

The responsibility of making award recommendations is the role of the Advisory Board. The Advisory Board members are Patricia Huscroft, Richard Huscroft, Scott Dempster, Peter Dempster and Vanessa Mair. If you have any questions, please contact one of the Advisory Board members. Their contact
